1. Pray.

Begin scripture study with prayer.
Ask for understanding as you study.
Express gratitude as you conclude.

2. Be Willing.

Pay the price of regular and diligent study.

3. Read Daily.

Set aside a specific and scheduled time each day.

4. Ponder.

Think about the truths, experiences, and lessons in the scriptures.
Take time—pondering cannot be forced, hurried, or rushed.

5. Write.

Record what you learn, think, and feel.
Invite the Holy Ghost to continue instruction.
